Did You Know?

-Today there is an estimated 200,000 homeless dogs roaming the streets and beaches of Puerto Rico. Because of overpopulation, lack of education, and shelters these dogs will die lonely and painful deaths on the streets of Puerto Rico.

-By law Puerto Rico is required to have 78 animal shelters, one for each city. Today there are 7 shelters, with over 125 dogs entering each shelter daily. 98% of these dogs will be euthanized.



WE PROVIDE:

- rescue for adoptable animals and rehabilitation services for the abused
 - humane education, "Kind News," which encourages kindness to animals, respect for natural habitats, good citizenship, and peaceful conflict resolution
 - food and medication to homeless dogs living on beaches/parks throughout Puerto Rico and humane societies in the US Virgin Islands
 - free or low cost spay/neuter services and vaccinations
- We promote responsible pet ownership
- We advocate shelter adoptions and work to eliminate puppy mills & "backyard" breeding
